Types of Sessions

- Paper (20 minutes)
It is an oral summary, with occasional reference to notes or texts that discuss the presenters' work in relation to theory and/or practice. Handouts and audiovisual aids are recommended.
- Workshop (1 hour)
It is a carefully structured, hands-on activity. The presenter acts as a facilitator in solving a problem or demonstrating a specific teaching technique. Handouts and audiovisual aids are recommended. The time slot includes the Q&A session (10 minutes).
- Roundtable Discussion (4 x 15 minutes)
Four presenters share their research or papers of similar topic in turn. The time allotted for one presentation is 15 minutes.
- Pecha Kucha (10 minutes)
A presentation is with 20 slides each shown for only 20 seconds (six minutes and 40 seconds in total). One session will accommodate up to 6 presentations. Handouts are recommended. There will be no Q&A session.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

- Abstract should be written in English.
- Abstract should not exceed 300 words.
- Abstract is to be written in Ms. Word (.doc) using Times New Roman, font size 11, on A4 paper.
- Abstract submission should include the following information:
 - a. Title of paper
 - b. Subtheme
 - c. Name(s) of author(s)
 - d. Affiliation(s): study program and university
 - e. Author(s) email(s)
 - f. Author(s) mailing address
 - g. Biographical data which should not exceed 100 words

Full Paper Submission

- Full papers must be written in English within 2500 – 3000 words.
- Full papers should be submitted to LSCAC2016@um.ac.id
- The name of the file is: **Full Paper_Name of University_Name(s) of Presenter**
- Full paper online submission is available on the website <http://lscac2016.um.ac.id>
- Full paper submission should adhere to the following guidelines:
 - a. Outline
 - Title
 - Name, institution, and email address
 - Abstract
 - Background of the Study
 - Method
 - Findings and Discussion
 - Conclusions and Suggestions
 - References
 - b. Technicalities
 - Title of Paper (16 pt Times New Roman Bold, align text to the center)
 - Name, institution, email address (12 pt Times New Roman, align text to the center)
 - Abstract (11 pt Times New Roman, align text to the center, justified)
 - Content of paper: Headings (14 pt Times New Roman)
 - The paragraph should be single spaced, left justified. Text should be in Times New Roman 12 pt. Do not use page numbering anywhere in the manuscript.
 - Allow a one-inch margin all around the border and an empty single space between each paragraph.
 - References (please conform to the requirements of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association 6th edition.) Visit the following website for reference to APA style:
